Metro

Closes around 9:30 PM on weekdays and 12:30 AM on weekends.
You can pay by card (around €1.70 to €2 per trip).

Bus 83: Corniche and Prado beaches (incredible sea views)
Bus 60: Easy access to Notre-Dame de la Garde
Bus 19 + 20: Access to the Calanques
