Must-see places

MUCEM (closed on Tuesdays)

Between modern architecture and sea views, it's perfect for an exhibition or a stroll.

Notre-Dame de la Garde

The famous "Bonne-Mère" watches over Marseille and offers spectacular panoramic views.

Vieux-Port

The heart of the city, ideal for strolling, watching the boats, and discovering the fish market in the morning.

Vélodrome stadium

A legendary place for football fans, with impressive architecture.

Le Panier district

Marseille's oldest neighbourhood: narrow streets, colourful facades, and artists studios.

Vallon des Auffes and Malmousque

A quieter, more authentic side of Marseille, between small fishing harbours and wild coves.
